Know What To Shred

Yes — Sales receipts; Paychecks; Credit card statements; Old checks and bank statements; Tax returns (but not instruction booklets); Medical bills & statements. Staples and paper clips are OK. Remove documents from binders.

No — The following are not allowed: Food, glass, cans, etc; Hanging folders, binders; Ink Cartridges; Nuts and bolts; Office tools (hole punch, staple remover, etc); Electronics, electrical items, hard drives or batteries.

The following should be taken to a recycling center: Newspapers, magazines, circulars; Cardboard tubes and boxes
